

Wildcats Win Over Caldwell, 56-54

Playing at Caldwell last Saturday night, the Mulvane high school Wildcats won a close non-league contest from the Bluejays by a score of 56 to 54.

Caldwell moved into a 13 to 11 first-quarter lead, and at halftime the Bluejays led 25 to 23. Coming back after the halftime intermission, Mulvane hit for 18 points in the third period, while Caldwell was being held to 12 counters, which gave the Wildcats a 41 to 37 lead at the start of the final period.

The final quarter saw Caldwell outscore Mulvane, 17 to 15, which pulled them up to within two points of knotting the score. The Bluejays missed on several scoring opportunities in the final seconds of play, as the Wildcats held on to their two point lead, which was their margin of victory.

Dave Parber led the Wildcat scoring with 13 points, followed by Steve Carmichael with 12.

The Mulvane B team also won their game handily over the Caldwell reserves, by a score of 61 to 37. Mulvane led, 27 to 18 at halftime, and then in the third period they broke the game wide open by hitting for 18 points, while holding Caldwell to 3 points.

Ron Wayman led the Mulvane scoring with 13 points, followed by Mickey Davey with 9. Gordon Long and David Hall had 8 each, and Bruce Kimble had 7.
