Oldridge, a senior, canned 21 points and was the only Wildcat in twin figures. Senior Chad Carpenter and junior guard Brian Strack had seven points each and Heinrichs and Parson scored six points apiece.

The Mulvane junior varsity checked in with its top game of the season, out-running the Eagles, 75-61, exploding after a sluggish first quarter. Mulvane ran up a 48-27 edge in the second and third quarters to break up the game.

Four players were in double figures with Jeremy Kendrick leading the way with 18 points. Larry Dixson scored 16 points, the center DeWald had 14 and Dan Smith scored 13.
