

Augusta Edges Wildcats, 92-90

By losing the final league game of the season to the Augusta Orioles by a breathtaking score of 92-90, Friday night, February 24, the Mulvane Wildcats marked their first Chisolm Trail league loss for a 7-1 record.

The Orioles were pouring on the points in the first quarter as they were ahead 10-0 at one time, and 24-16 at the end of the quarter. Mulvane made 29 points in the second quarter to Augusta's 28, with Augusta coming out on top 52-45 at the half.

The Wildcats outclassed the Orioles in the third quarter, making 22 points to Augusta's 16, and were within one point, 68-67, at the end of the third quarter. Augusta scored 24 points in the fourth period to Mulvane's 23, to gain their two point victory.

The score was tied at 90-90 in the last 3 seconds, but Roger Hill pulled Augusta to victory with a mid-court swish to end the game.

Mulvane's Jerry Webster was the outstanding scorer with 35 points on 11 fieldgoals and 13 free throws. Jim Prins played one of his best games, as did Gary Richards, by making 23 and 14 points respectively. Van Tarr, another Wildcat, put 12 points to round out the big four of Mulvane.

Augusta was sporting three outstanding scorers with Robert Stroud's 34 points, Roger Hill's 25 points and Wayne Dusenbury's 19 points.
