

Valley Center Tops Wildcats

The Chisholm Trail League champions—the Valley Center Hornets—jumped off to a big first period lead and went on to defeat the Mulvane High School Wildcats, 58-44, here on Friday.

The taller Hornets popped out to a 20-6 first quarter lead and that about wrapped up the game. Mulvane battled back to within 12 points at a couple of times during the second half.

Actually, it was extremely cold first period shooting that doomed Mulvane. The Wildcats could muster just two field goals of 14 attempts for 14 percent. Things picked up a bit in the second quarter, with Mulvane netting 6 of 13. However, it was too late to turn the game around.

One of the highlights of the contest was Mulvane's near perfect performance at the free throw line. The Wildcats connected on 16 of 18 charity attempts for an 87 percent mark. From the field, for the game, Mulvane could muster just 28 percent.

Sophomore Brent Fleming continued his scoring rampage, can-

ning 21 points to pace the Mulvane attack. The 6-0 center also led the rebounding with nine. He was the only Wildcat in double figures.
