

Goddard Ends Wildcats Season

Goddard's Lions ended the 1971-72 cage season for the Mulvane Wildcats with an 89-50 win in Class 3-A Regional action at the Goddard gym on Tuesday.

The Wildcats jumped into a quick 4-0 lead, using slow-down tactics. However, Goddard went on a scoring spree and netted 25 points during the remainder of the first period and took a 25-8 lead.

Goddard rebounded with 15 more in the second period against 18 for Mulvane. This gave the Lions a 40-26 margin. However, a 25-point Goddard scoring spree in the third period put the game out of reach for the Wildcats.

Dan Carmichael, 6-5 junior center, paced the Mulvane attack with 21 points—a career high. Steve Butts added 16 points in his final game as a Wildcat. Ken Koenigs, the Lions' fine 6-7 sophomore, canned 23 points to pace the Goddard attack, while Pat Mosley and Mark Delmar added 15 tallies each.

The Wildcats finished the year with a 5-15 mark.

LOSE TO VALLEY

The Wildcats dropped a non-conference game to the Valley Center Hornets, 71-56, at Valley Center last Friday.

The 'Cats stayed close to the Hornets in the early going and trailed only 15-13 with less than three minutes remaining in the initial period. However, Mulvane hit a cold streak and netted only a pair of tallies while Valley canned 11 to move to a 27-15 first period lead.

The Wildcats' icy shooting continued in the second period and Valley built a 49-23 lead at intermission.

Mulvane's attack was hampered by fouls on leading scorer Terry Craig and 6-5 center Dan Carmichael. Both left the contest early via the foul route.

Carmichael was Mulvane's leading scorer. The rapidly-improving postman canned 14 tallies to pace the attack. He pulled down seven rebounds. Terry Craig and Skip Day were in second spot with 10 tallies each.

Steve Butts was Mulvane's

leading rebounder with eight.
