It was the stuff dreams are made of. Mulvane led Chaparral 67-59 with just over two minutes left to play in a sub-state game.

Then Mulvane woke up.

They woke up to watch Roadrunner star Corbin Hostetler lead Chaparral on a 13-0 run to end the game and Mulvane's season.

"We succumbed to their pressure," coach Dale Landes said. "We didn't execute and had silly mistakes."

Mulvane built the lead behind a solid offensive effort. Dexter Carpenter scored a learn-high 20 points in an concerted effort to get him the ball.

"We wanted to exploit their lack of interior defense," Landes said. "We were laying so well I was thinking about the scond round."

But the game, and the season, came down to the last two minutes. The Wildcats had already sustained one run by Chaparral, but when Carpenter and Jeremy Brown fouled out, things started spiraling downhill for Mulvane.

"Jeremy fouling out was crucial because he had been doing a great job handling the press," Landes said.

Hostetler completed his 35-point effort with 21 points in the final quarter.

"He just took over the game," Landes said.

The pressure-defense forced Mulvane into bad passes and shots. The Cats were not trying to just run out the clock.

"I told them to be aggressive with the ball. Trying to hold the ball has not worked for us this season," Landes said. "If we had a few more wins under our belt we could handle it, but we seem to lose our composure."

Michael Abasolo netted 12 points and Shawn Erbert scored 10 for Mulvane.

In a postponed game, Mulvane fell to Clearwater Friday, Feb. 24 by a score of 58-40. Abasolo led the Cats with 18 points.

The night before, Mulvane lost to Circle 42-36. Jeff Parker hit for 15 points, while Abasolo added 14.
