

Win District Tourney Trophy

The Mulvane high school Wildcats copped the championship trophy at the Caldwell district tournament last week as they downed Anthony 56 to 48 in the finals last Friday night. The Wildcats worked their way into the finals by defeating Belle Plaine 44 to 35 in the semi-finals on Thursday night.

The final tilt against Anthony was a close affair all the way, with the lead changing hands several times. It was late in the final period that Mulvane pulled away quickly to sew up the championship.

Darrell Reed scored 20 points for the Wildcats, followed by Kimble with 19, and Wenzel had 14. Kimble dropped in six of his points in the final two minutes to assure the Mulvane victory.

In the semi-final game with Belle Plaine, the Wildcats held a one point margin at halftime, 18 to 17, Belle Plaine led at the third quarter stop, 28 to 26, but in the final period Mulvane poured on the steam to score 18 points while holding Belle Plaine to 7. Darrell Reed paced the scoring with 17 points.

Both Mulvane and Anthony will go to the regional tournament at Haven.
