

Wildcats Playing In Regional Tourney

The Mulvane high school Wildcats took a narrow 52 to 50 victory over Moundridge in their first game of the class A regional tourney at Augusta Wednesday night. Augusta won over Fredonia, 59 to 58, so Mulvane and Augusta will play each other in the 8:30 semi-final Thursday night. By virtue of first round victories, Valley Center and O'role play in the 7:30 semi-final Thursday night.

Moundridge took a 13 to 10 first quarter lead, and at halftime held a 26 to 19 advantage over Mulvane. It was in the third period that the Wildcats really sacked up the game, hitting for 17 points while holding Moundridge to 6.

Gordon Long paced the Mulvane scoring with 17 points. Bruce Kimble had 12 points, seven of which came in the crucial final quarter; Mickey Davey and Ted Richardson had 8 each; Steve Carmichael had 5 points and Steve Roney had 2.

The consolation and championship games will be played Friday night. Winner of the regional will go to the state class A tournament next week.
