

# Win First Game At Regional

The Mulvane high school Wildcats moved into the semi-finals of the class A regional tourney at Buhler by trouncing Andover, 75 to 52, on Wed. night. In the other tourney game Wed. night, Sacred Heart of Salina edged by Valley Center, 60 to 59.

In the first semi-final game Thursday night, Eureka and Herington were scheduled to play at 7 o'clock. They were winners of games played Tuesday night. At 8:30 Thursday night Mulvane met Sacred Heart.

The consolation and championship games will be played Friday night at the same times, with the two Thursday night winners playing for the championship and a ticket to the state tourney, and the two Thursday night losers will play in the consolation tilt.

In their game with Andover the Wildcats jumped into the lead at the beginning of the contest and then led all the way. At halftime Mulvane held a 38 to 15 advantage. All 10 of the Wildcat squad saw action in the game, with 9 of them figuring in the scoring. Steve Carmichael led the Mulvane scoring attack with 26 points.
