

Wildcats Lose In Regional

Wichita Notre Dame upset the Mulvane high school Wildcats, 52 to 45, in the class A regional tourney at Circle high Wednesday night. Griffin of Notre Dame hit six free throws in the final two minutes to give his team the victory, as the Wichita cagers played a stall game in the last three minutes.

Valley Center defeated Andover, 82 to 57 in the other game Wednesday night. This will put Valley Center against Notre Dame in one of the semi-finals Friday night, and Buhler and Circle will play in the other semi-final contest.

Notre Dame jumped into a 13 to 4 lead at the end of the initial period. At halftime Notre Dame led 30 to 25.

Mulvane outscored Notre Dame in the third period, to trail by only one point, 40 to 39, at the end of the third quarter. For the game, Mulvane had 20 field goals, to 16 for Notre Dame, but the difference was at the free throw line. Notre Dame hit for 20 points at the charity stripe, while Mulvane had only 8 points. Mulvane was charged with 17 personal fouls, to 10 for Notre Dame.

The loss eliminated Mulvane from the tourney and brings their 1963-64 season to a close.
