

# Lose to Augusta In Tournament

Mulvane wrapped up the 1969 basketball season during the past week by suffering two defeats. Friday the Wildcats bowed to Circle here, 77-52, and Tuesday night Mulvane was eliminated from the regional tournament at Circle after losing to Augusta, 83-50.

Friday, which was homecoming for the Wildcats, ended with the Circle Thunderbirds handing them their seventh league loss. Mike McKee was high point man for Mulvane with 14 points, followed by Jim Crawford with 13.

Tuesday night the Wildcats traveled to Circle to play against the Orioles of Augusta. Behind the scoring of senior Bob Colvin, Augusta blew Mulvane off the court by a 23 point margin, 83-50. Ted Hill and Dan Brauser led the Wildcat scoring with 14 and 13 points. Mulvane was ahead early in the game, 12-9, but never saw light again. The fact that Augusta shot an excellent 50 percent from the field did not help the Wildcats cause much either.

Overall Coach Jim Harris has done a commendable job this year with his Wildcat team. Also Wildcat fans can look forward to an excellent team next year.
