

In Thursday night's semi-finals, the Caldwell Bluejays overpowered the Planeview Gremlins 60-54. Lavan Jackson and Floyd Perry of Planeview were high scorers with 19 points each. Rudy Dvorak, Ronald Hula and Stuart Luder, all of Caldwell each had 13 points. The Grems edged out in front and were ahead 13-12 at the end of the first quarter and 29-25 at the half, but were out-scored in the third and trailed 52-44 at the end of the third period.
