

Circle thrashes Wildcats 60-36

The Circle Thunderbirds just about buried the Wildcats in the first quarter when, down 18 to 5, they fought back to only be outscored 16 to 11 in the second quarter. The Wildcats were led by Mark Steadman who scored 12 points in only two quarters. Steadman was followed by senior Robbie Fry who scored 8 points. Mulvane lacked offense throughout the contest as the Wildcats for the first time this season scored under 40 points. Circle was paced by number 51, Rusty Collins, who scored a game high of 24 points. 14 of those points came in the first half.

In the first quarter Mulvane was outscored 18 to 5 as the Circle Thunderbirds shot 53 per cent, compared to

50 per cent for Mulvane. In the second quarter Mulvane ended up shooting 23 per cent for the quarter as Mulvane scored 11 points to Circle's 16.

Mulvane was outscored 15 to 6 in the third quarter as Mulvane could only shoot 11 per cent. The Wildcats did outscore Circle 14 to 11 in the final quarter. Circle ended up by shooting 33 per cent in the second half as the Wildcats again shot 23 per cent.
