

Valley Center, Anderson stop 'Cats 75 to 59

The No. 3 ranked Valley Center Hornets pinned the 15th loss on the Mulvane Wildcats Friday night. Valley Center moved to 11 and 2 in the league and 17 and 2 overall. The story of the game was Valley Center's junior forward John Anderson's 38 points. Mulvane was led by Robbie Fry (19), Brad Butts (12), and Mark Steadman (10).
