

Wildcats Lose At Regional Tourney

The Mulvane high school Wildcats dropped both games in which they played at the regional tourney last week at Haven. On the opening night of play, Friday night, Haven handed the Wildcats a 64 to 54 defeat.

In the consolation game on Saturday night the Wildcats were edged out by Sterling by one point, 63 to 62.

In the game with Haven, it was nip and tuck through the first half, with Haven holding a 30 to 28 half-time lead. In the final period Haven pulled steadily ahead to win by a margin of 10 points.

In the consolation game with Sterling, Mulvane put on a blazing finish to score 24 points in the final stanza, and fall just one point short of overcoming a nine point lead Sterling had built up by the end of the third quarter.
