

Mulvane Takes Third In Tournament Here

Disappointed fans were turned away from the finals of Mulvane's class A sub-regional basketball tournament last Friday night as a capacity crowd of approximately 1,000 fans saw Augusta defeat the Anthony Pirates 62-40 in a thrilling game.

Augusta led the strong southern Kansas runner-up team all the way, with period scores of 12-9, 34-26, and 42-29. Truby of Anthony was high point man with 20 points, with Hurst of Augusta close by with 16.

Mulvane Wildcats edged Caldwell 41-37 to take third place in the tournament. Leading 12-9 at the end of the first quarter, Mulvane fell behind 19-16 at half-time. Mulvane's attack of 17 points in the third quarter gave them a 33-30 margin going into the final quarter. Only one point separated the two teams a couple of times during the fourth period. Duane Reusser led the scoring with eight field goals for a total of 16 points while Tackett led Caldwell's scoring with 12.

Thursday night's semi-finals found the strong Augusta team leading Caldwell all the way with period scores 9-5, 23-11, 44-18, and 62-29. Anthony had as easy a time defeating the host Mulvane Wildcats with period scores 11-5, 27-16, 42-28, and 59-32. Eldon Peterson was high for Mulvane with 12 points while Anthony's Truby marked 16.

Mulvane came out on the long end of the first game of the tourney Wednesday night, defeating Harper, 47-44. Duane Reusser was high point man for the evening with 19, Harper's leading scorer being Foyle with 14. In the other game, Caldwell defeated Andale 45-31, leading all the way. Tackett was high for Caldwell with 16 and Carpenter led Andale's scoring with 11.

Supt. W. D. Munson, tournament manager, had high praise in his remarks, before presentation of the trophies, for the fine sportmanship shown by the participating teams, their coaches and fans. He also praised the officials, Gib Webb of Clearwater and Lee Bonine of Wichita, for their fine work in handling the games.
