

Kapaun-Mt. Carmel Ends Cats Season

The rugged Kapaun-Mt. Carmel Crusaders ended the 1974-75 basketball season for the Mulvane High School Wildcats, with an 81-44 victory in the first round of the Sub-State Tournament at Goddard last week.

Kapaun jumped off to an 8-0 lead and increased the margin to 18-9 at the end of the first quarter. By halftime, the Crusaders held a 41-23 lead. Mulvane rallied a bit in the third quarter 10 field goals of 14 attempts. At the buzzer, Kapaun led 63-43. Mulvane netted only one point in the final period.

In all, Mulvane hit 18 of 47 field goal attempts for 38 percent. Kapaun outrebounded the Cats, 38-29.
