

The Mulvane Wildcat eagers were dropped in the semi-finals at the class A regional tournament in the game with Eureka by a score of 37 to 32.

By close scoring the last half the Wildcats managed to remain close behind the Eureka Tornadoes to the end. The Mulvane quintet went into the semi-finals by defeating Neodesha 40 to 32 in the first round of the tournament.
