

Mulvane Wildcats To The State Tournament

Won Regional at Arkansas City

WINS FIRST GAME

Mulvane won its first game at the state tournament at Hutchinson from Onaga by a score of 48 to 30.

Taking the lead from the start, the Mulvane Wildcats beat the Clearwater Indians last Saturday night in a thrilling and spectacular game at Ark City, 49 to 22, making the Wildcats the winner of the Regional Tournament.

Playing and winning three games during last week, they beat Cedar Vale 48 to 23 Thursday afternoon. McGinnis scored high with 19 points, and Galvan with 12 points.

The Wildcats then played Argonia on Friday afternoon and beat them 32 to 27, with McGinnis again high point man with 14 points.
