

Mulvane Loses At State Tourney

The Mulvane high school Wildcats were eliminated from the class A state basketball tournament at Hutchinson last Thursday night when they lost to the Larned Indians, 49 to 44, in the opening round of play. Larned went on to the finals, losing to Chapman in the championship game Saturday night.

Mulvane held a 12 to 10 first quarter lead over Larned, and at halftime the Wildcats were ahead, 25 to 23. It was in the third period that Larned caught up with Mulvane and pulled ahead by two points, 39 to 37 as the period ended.

Midway in the final period, on the basis of three charity tosses and a field goal, Larned pulled to a 44 to 39 lead. While the Wildcats scored two more field goals and a charity toss, Larned hit five more charity tosses and won by a five point margin, 49 to 44.

Carmichael led the Wildcat scoring with 19 points, followed by Richardson with 11. Zook was high for Larned with 15.
