

Mulvane Clobbers Oxford, 76 - 50

Mulvane High School opened the 1970-71 basketball season with a 76-50 victory over Oxford in a non-league game played Tuesday night at Mulvane.

Mulvane hit 52% of their shots from the field which is very surprising for the first game. Mulvane also out-rebounded their opponents in every stanza.

Mulvane built their lead with two hot periods. In the final three minutes of the first quarter, the 'Cats outscored Oxford, 10-1. In the last minute of the contest Mulvane outscored Oxford, 7-0. Mulvane suffered a period late in the first half where they did not score a point for over four minutes.

Terry Craig paced a balanced scoring attack for Mulvane with 19 points. Craig Levering added 16 tallies, while Max Nichols had 15 and Rick Farber, 12 points. Farber was the game's leading rebounder with 18 and Nichols had 10.
