Quick Augusta Shells Wildcats

"Now we know what we have to work on." Words are small consolation for Mulvane boys basketball coach Charlie Mason whose charges opened the season at home Tuesday night, Dec. 2, on a sour note.

The Wildcats were out-quicked and out-played by Augusta, 63-37, in a Chisholm Trail League game. The MHS junior varsity also took it on the chin, as did the sophomore team. The Augusta jayvees clipped the Cats, 52-33, and the Oriole sophs plastered Mulvane, 39-25.

"Now we know what we have to work on," stressed a disappointed Mason, who got rough treatment on the dawn of his second year as the head coach. "We have to work more on our defense and our offense against the pressure defense. We have to be able to put the ball in the hole against pressure defense, and we didn't."

A half-court pressing defense employed by the Orioles kept the Cats from any organized attempt and the offense also showed that Augusta was considerably quicker than the Cats. After taking a 14-9 lead in the opening period, Augusta plowed ahead to pull away.

The Orioles' pressure defense forced 23 Mulvane turnovers while Augusta had only 15. "That was one of the biggest differences," said Mason. "They handled the ball a lot better than we did. What pressure we put on, they handled. And we didn't handle theirs. They took us out of what we tried to do. They did have good quickness and they kept us from running our offense."

The Cats weren't able to contain Augusta on the boards, either, despite having a size advantage. Augusta came away with 30 rebounds to 21 for the locals. Senior Kevin Burke had nine to
