

Lose First Cage Game To Derby

The Mulvane high school Wildcats opened the 1963-64 basketball season Tuesday night at Derby, where the Panthers defeated them, 61 to 52, in a non-league game. A packed house witnessed the opening games.

Derby jumped off to a 20 to 10 first quarter lead and at halftime held a 31 to 24 advantage. Coming back after the halftime intermission Mulvane closed the gap during the third period, and trailed by only 3 points as the quarter ended, 40 to 37 for Derby.

Early in the final period, the Wildcats kept close on Derby before the Panthers pulled away in the final stages to win by a nine point margin.

Eleven Wildcats saw action in the game, and Dave Farber led the scoring with 14 points. He was followed by Steve Carmichael, who had 10.

Leading the scoring for Derby was Dan Gaskin with 22 points and David Hamilton with 18.
