

Lose Opener To Derby, 39-30

The Mulvane High School Wildcats opened the basketball season last Friday on their home court, when they lost to Derby, 39 to 30. An overflow crowd was on hand for the season opener, also a league tilt.

Mulvane jumped out into an early first period lead, and the period ended with the Wildcats in front 6 to 4. Late in the second quarter Derby caught up with the Wildcats and emerged with a 18 to 15 half time lead.
