

Winfield Hands Loss To Cats

The Winfield Vikings jumped off to a big first period lead and went on to defeat Mulvane, 73-51, in a game played at Winfield last week.

Actually, the Wildcats played the taller Vikings on a reasonably even basis during the second half. On several occasions, Mulvane came within 14 points of Winfield.

Midway in the first period, the Vikings utilized a rugged full-court press coupled with cold shooting by the 'Cats to break the contest open. Mulvane was trailing, 6-4, when the Vikings ripped off 15 unanswered points

and moved out to a 25-7 first period lead. Winfield increased the margin to 42-22 at halftime. During the third period, Mulvane outscored Winfield, 16-11.

Brent Fleming paced the Mulvane attack with 15 points. Jim Carr added 13 tallies and Dave McKinney netted 10 points.

During the first half, Mulvane hit just seven field goals on 20 attempts for 35 percent. Overall, the 'Cats were 17 of 45 for 37 percent.

Fleming also paced the rebounding for Mulvane. The 6-1 junior grabbed 12. Others on the rebounding chart were David McKinney, Jerry Shoemaker, 5 each; Gayland Titus, 4; Jesse Morgan, 3; Mark Cranston, 2, and Jim Carr, 1.
