

# Mulvane Boys Flash Renewed Spirit In Split

Cheney erased a two-point Mulvane lead with a six-point play late in the game to ease past the Wildcats, 62-60, in a non-league game Tuesday night, Dec. 4, in Mulvane.

The defeat evened Mulvane's record at 1-1 under new coach Charlie Mason but didn't dampen his renewed excitement about the ball club. "That was a good ball game from a spectator standpoint and also from the standpoint of our execution," said Mason. "We really played pretty good. You shoot 45 percent, out-board 'em by 12 and play good defense, you ought to win. I felt the officials took it away from us, though."

The whole ball game swirled around the last 1:13. In a tight ball game, Mulvane held on to a 56-54 lead when Cheney guard Mark Bohm, who finished with a game-high 34 points, stole a pass and headed for a layup. Officials whistled a foul on Mulvane guard Troy Phillips as Bohm shot and made the layup.

When Phillips protested too strongly, officials called a technical. Bohm made both the "T" shot and the free throw, then Cheney's John Ewing hit two free throws to cap off the six-point play, giving Cheney a 50-56 lead with :41 left.

"We got some calls at the wrong time," complained Mason. "We shoot five (free throws) and they shoot 36. We're playing an aggressive man-to-man, but...."

"It was a learning experience," added Mason. "We learned how to play under pressure, how to play as a team with three starters on the bench and we are going to have to learn how to adjust to the officials."

All the statistics point to a Mulvane victory to match the season-opening assault of Augusta, 66-48, Friday night, Nov. 30. With 6-foot-2 seniors Mark Storey and Mark Smith each getting nine rebounds, Mulvane came away with a 37-25 edge there.

The Wildcat B-team, with Burke scoring 11 points and Hamilton eight, won its first game of the season, dumping Cheney, 48-42.

Against Augusta, guard Jeff Staska pumped in 14 points and Smith and Storey each had 11 points.
