

Moundridge Downs Wildcats in Opener

The Mulvane Wildcats opened the basketball season on a sad note last Friday night as Moundridge defeated the Wildcats twice. Mulvane lost the A game 60-35 and the B game 62-34.

The Wildcat A team grabbed a quick 6-0 lead and trailed 14-12 at the end of the first quarter. But then came what will probably be the most disastrous quarter of the whole season. Terry Bally had scored two field goals and rebounded well until midway through the second quarter when he injured a knee and missed the rest of the game.

About a minute after Bally's injury Quinn Radford hurt his knee and missed the rest of the game. Radford had scored five points before his injuries. At halftime, the Wildcats trailed 27-23. Mulvane was outscored 35-11 in the last half and Moundridge won 62-34.
