

Wildcats Down Derby, 60-52

Playing before a capacity crowd in their first home basketball game of the season Tuesday night, the Mulvane high school Wildcats downed the Derby Panthers, 60 to 52. It was the second straight win of the new season for Mulvane.

Mulvane took the lead in the opening minutes of the game but as the quarter ended, Derby pulled up even, the score reading 12 to 12. At halftime Derby held a one point margin, 27 to 26. Mulvane pulled ahead in the third period to hold a slim 43 to 40 third quarter advantage, and then they widened the gap in the final stanza to win by an 8 point margin.

Steve Carmichael grabbed scoring honors in the game by tossing in 22 points, 10 fielders and a pair of charity tosses; he was followed by Gordon Long with 16, and Mickey Davey had 12.

Coach Jerry Webster said he was pleased with the heads up, hard driving play of the boys in this early season game. Our shooting was good, and our defense tough, he added.

The Mulvane B team lost a thriller to the Derby reserves, 48 to 46. Mulvane was behind 41 to 29 at the end of the third period, and they really poured on the steam in the final quarter to score 17 points, and almost overtake the Panther reserves. Steve Layton and Quinn Radford shared scoring honors with 12 points each.
