

Wildcats Triumph Over Caldwell Bluejays

Local Wildcats handed the Caldwell Bluejays a 49-35 defeat Tuesday night in a basketball game on the Mulvane court.

Mulvane led throughout the slow-moving game. Both teams were overly-cautious and defensive play was very tight.
