

Panthers Pounce On Mulvane, 43-33

The Derby Panthers, bent upon inaugurating their brand new gym in complete fashion, erased a half-time deficit of 21-12 and came to life in the last two stanzas last Friday night to down the Mulvane Wildcats 43-33 before a "big" house.

This tilt marked the first game of the season for the Wildcats. The locals didn't have the basket zeroed in and were only able to hit 19.2 per cent of their field goal attempts and they only completed 17 out of a possible 32 attempts at the charity stripe.

Don Reed was high point man for the game with 4 field goals and 4 free tosses, followed by Kimble with a total of 8. Pullium was high pointer for the winners with a total of 11 but it was Morris Logue who proved to be the thorn in the side of Mulvane in the third frame. Logue, a 6 footer, scored 6 quick points to put the bee on the Wildcats, and to bring his club within firing range of the visitors. Derby gained the lead with 4:10 left in the third, a lead they never relinquished. Fouls were frequent. Derby also won the B game 44-21.
