

Mulvane Wins 1st Game From Derby

Jerry Leatherman paced the Mulvane Wildcats in their kickoff tilt in the Chisholm Trails basketball race at Derby last Friday night by racking up 29 points for himself—1 point less than the Panthers total as the locals won 64-30.

In his total of 29, Letherman hit a neat 50 percent of his field goal attempts. He chalked up 11 charity tosses.

The Wildcats jumped off to an early lead and were never in hot water during the test. Derby was punctured via the foul route when 4 of their starters left the floor in the last quarter. Morris Logue led the Panthers scorers with 8; Backman had 7, Fairchild had 6, Darrow and Carrell 5 and 4 respectively.
