

Goddard Hands Cats 73-54 League Loss

Goddard's talented Lions exploded in the second quarter and went on to defeat the Mulvane Wildcats, 73-54, in a Chisholm Trail League game, here, last Friday.

In many ways, it was probably Mulvane's best effort of the year. The Wildcats stayed reasonably close to Goddard until late in the contest.

The Lions held a slim, 14-10 lead going into the second period. However, they limited Mulvane to just 12 points while scoring 20 to pull away. The most spectacular shot of the game took place at the half-time buzzer, when 6-9 Ken Koenigs netted a half court hook shot.

Mulvane battled back to come within 10 points during the third period, but again, the Lions' superior size and hot outside shooting overpowered Mulvane.

Goddard hit an even 60 percent, canning 32 of 52. Mulvane's shooting was respectable. The Wildcats canned 19 of 46 for 41 percent.

Brent Fleming paced the Wildcat attack with 22 points. Mark Cranston was the only 'Cat in double figures, hitting 10 points.

Fleming also led the rebounding. The 6-1 junior grabbed 14. Others on the rebounding chart were David McKinney, 5; Jerry Shoemaker and Curtis Roberts, 4 each; Jim Carr, 3; David Miller, 2, and Mark Cranston, 1.
