

Wildcats Down Andale, 66-35

The Mulvane high school Wildcats opened the home season basketball schedule last Friday night by scoring a thumping 66 to 35 victory over Andale. This game was a league contest.

The Wildcats had played their first two games on the road, at Derby and Buhler, both of which they lost.

The Wildcats really found the range of the basket in this game, with Reed leading the scoring with 17 points and Norden was close on his heels with 16 points. These boys were also hogging the rebounds, with Norden taking down 13 for the night, and Reed had 25.
