

# Goddard Lions Hand Wildcat League Loss

A second quarter splurge powered the Goddard Lions to a 60-49 Chisholm Trail League basketball win over the Mulvane Wildcats at Goddard last Friday.

The Wildcats opened the contest with a stall and trailed the highly-ranked Lions by a 5-2 margin. However, in the second stanza, Goddard canned 27 points and held Mulvane to just 8.

Going into the fourth period, Goddard held a 40-18 lead. However, Mulvane cut loose an efficient full-court press and outscored the Lions 31-15.

"Overall, we were pleased with the performance," Mulvane Head Coach Carl Felver said. "We stayed with them and, if we'd played as well against Derby, we might have won that game."

Felver singled out Brent Fleming, Dan Carmichael, Jerry Shoemaker, Terry Allred and Curtis Roberts for special praise. "They really hustled," he added. "And, Dave Carney did a good job on defense."

Carmichael and Fleming paced the Wildcats attack with 11 and 10 points respectively. Carmichael topped Mulvane's re-

bouncing with 11, while Fleming added nine.

Overall, Mulvane hit 40 percent of their shots from the floor, while Goddard canned 47 percent. Mulvane netted an excellent 78 percent of their free throws. The Wildcats were hampered by 33 turnovers during the game.
