

# Wildcats Lose To Andale, 65-51

The Mulvane Wildcats suffered defeat last Friday evening as the Andale Indians gained a 65-51 victory. It was the Wildcats second loss in three starts. Coach Miller's team was unable to hit with much accuracy from the field.
