

Wildcats Win Over Sedgwick

The Mulvane Wildcats racked up their third straight victory in the still young basketball season as they defeated Sedgwick, 68 to 55. The game was played on the home floor.

Mulvane took the lead early in the first period, and held it throughout the game. At halftime the Wildcats held a 29 to 21 advantage. It was in the third quarter that Mulvane really put the game away for keeps as they hit for 23 points, seven fielders and nine from the charity line, while holding Sedgwick to 14 points.

Gordon Long paced the Wildcat scoring with 19 points, followed by Ted Richardson with 17. Jim Phillips was high for the visitors with 18 points.

The Wildcats B team also won an easy victory as they downed the Sedgwick reserves, 50 to 31. Again in this preliminary contest, Mulvane moved out into the lead early and held it all the way. At halftime they led, 27 to 11, and in the third period the Wildcats hit for 15 points while Sedgwick could hit for only 4.
