

# Wildcats Lose To Goddard Lions

Goddard's lanky Lions parlayed a second-quarter splurge to notch a 70-49 Chisholm Trail League win over the Mulvane Wildcats last Friday.

The culprit, as far as the Wildcats were concerned, was Pat Moseley, a 6-2 senior guard. With the 'Cats trailing by just four—23-19—midway through the second stanza, Moseley went on a scoring binge. He canned six straight points and plucked off a pass and fired to Mike Dold for a lay-up. By that time, Goddard had moved out to a 12-point lead and, that was about it for Mulvane.

Fouls actually kept the 'Cats out of contention. Terry Craig, hustling senior guard, fouled out with just a minute-thirty gone in the second half. Craig sat out the entire second period with four fouls.

Dave Carmichael and Skip Day also left the contest early via the foul route. Although behind, the 'Cats continued to harass the Lions, on a couple of occasions, in the second half, it appeared that Mulvane would battle back into the contest.

Skip Day paced the Mulvane scoring with 15 tallies. Day, Troy Richardson, Dave Carney, and Randy Martinez each scored several steals during the second half.

Dan Carmichael, 6-5 junior, paced the Wildcat rebounding with 10. It was the first start for Carmichael. His brother, Dave, was second in the rebounding derby with 8.

Ken Koenig, a 6-7 sophomore, topped Goddard with 19 points and 16 rebounds. Moseley had 16 points and Mark Delmar netted ten points.

One of the 'Cats' big hang-ups was free throw shooting. They were able to hit only 13 of 26

for a weak 50 percent. They were 18 of 43 from the field for 44 percent.

"I was proud of their hustle," Head Coach Bob Dohm said after the game. "The boys worked real hard."
