

# Cheney Chops Wildcats 73-51

The Mulvane Wildcats traveled to Cheney Tuesday night hoping to even their record but instead they suffered a 73 to 51 defeat at the hands of the Cardinals. Coach Roger Pock pointed out that the difference in the contest was in the turnover department. The Cats suffered 45 turnovers compared to Cheney's 15. The Wildcats were unable to break the press that Cheney put on Mulvane almost the whole night. The loss for Mulvane was their second of the young season against no wins. The contest was the first for Cheney which now stands at 1 and 0. The Wildcats out rebounded the Cardinals by 18, 42-24. Leading the way for the Mulvane attack was senior Mark Steadman who scored 14 and junior forward Brad

Butts who scored 13 points. Cheney was led by Twietmyer who popped in 16 points and Rosenhagan who scored 15 points.

The rebounding department for the Cats was led by Butts who had 11 and Robbie Fry and Perry Caldwell who both had 8. The first quarter ended with the score Cheney 21, Mulvane 10. The Cats came out and held the Cardinals to just 13 points as the halftime score was Cheney 34, Mulvane 23. In the third quarter Mulvane could only score 12 points but again held Cheney to 13. Going into the fourth quarter, Mulvane trailed by 12 points, but that did not help as Cheney exploded for 26 points and won going away 73 to 51. The next outing for the Cats is at Goddard and then home for two games before Christmas vacation.
