

# Wildcats Down Andale, 62-45

Coach Harold Brandenburg's Mulvane Wildcats established a perfect stage for home town fans last Friday night when they dominated a fast moving court session with the Andale Indians to win 62-45.

The Wildcats quickly erected a 16-8 lead in the initial stanza, a lead they never relinquished throughout the tussel.
