

Mulvane Defeats Clearwater, 61-36

Playing their first home game last Friday night, the Mulvane High School Wildcats defeated the Clearwater Indians, 61 to 36, in a Chisholm Trail league game. Mulvane jumped out to a 14 to 8 first-quarter lead and by halftime they held a 27 to 17 advantage.

The Wildcats really poured it on in the third period as they netted 22 points, while Clearwater made only 5 points. Coach Jerry Webster cleared the bench in the latter stages of the contest, as 11 Wildcats saw action in the game.
