

Lose First Game To Kingman, 48 - 38

The Mulvane Wildcats lost their first game of the season to Kingman last Saturday night by a score of 48-38.

The Wildcats trailed by only one point at the end of the first period but could only manage 5 points in the second quarter and fell to a 25-14 halftime deficit.

Mulvane almost doubled their first half score in the third period and raised their score to 27 but were still down by 15. In the fourth stanza the Wildcats outscored their opponents, 11-6, but fell 10 short on their bid for a perfect 4-0 mark.

High scorers for Mulvane were Dan Brauser and Jim Crawford with 12 each. Ted Hill, the only other Wildcat in double figures, added 10.

The last 1969 basketball game will be played in Mulvane against Hillsboro on December 19. The Wildcats resume the season on January 2 of 1970 when they play the Andover Trojans on their home court.
