

Wildcats Beat Goddard

Mulvane Wildcats, led by Kent Hughes with 31 points, took a double overtime 75-74 victory last week over Goddard.

The win, the second this year for the Wildcats, sent Wildcat fans streaming onto the floor to surround the coaches and players.

The game was won by Hughes when he sunk a freethrow with nine seconds to go in the second overtime. His shot made the score 75-72.

A last minute basket by

Goddard at the buzzer brought them within a point of the Wildcats.

The Wildcats came fighting back in the second quarter as they trailed 32-18 at one point.

At halftime the Wildcats had cut this gap to two points. The halftime score was Goddard 35 - Mulvane 33.

Mike Alumbaugh scored 12 points to provide a vital assist for the Wildcats. Jeff Crawford scored 11 points to Alumbaugh a close race in scoring.

Other Wildcat scorers were Ed Stunkel with eight points; Ronnie Turner, six points; Robbie Fry, three points; and Brad Butts and Brad Sorenson two points each.

Stunkel led the Wildcats in rebounds with 13.

The Mulvane-Goddard game was a preview of the Jan. 9 game which will open league

play for the Wildcats. This time the game will be at Goddard.

The Wildcat "B" Team lost a close 64-59 game to Goddard. Mark Steadman scored 26 points for the Wildcats. Eighteen of his points were in the third quarter of the game.

The Wildcat sophomore team lost a 62-48 game against Goddard.
