Wildcats Down Valley Center, 50-48

Mulvane grabbed an early lead and held tight against Valley Center Friday to down the Hornets 50-48 in a Chisholm Trail league basketball game played at Valley Center. Led by Dick Peckham and Keith Greiner, who combined to score 26 points, the Wildcats won this second league game against no defeats and thus far have a 3-0 season record.

The Wildcats jumped off to a 4-0 lead on quick passes from Kincaid to Leatherman, who sunk a pair of fielders. The first half moved slowly, with fouls forcing Floyd Shoup to the bench.

Mulvane led at the end of the first period 13-8. Opening the second period, Shoup hit a set-up and a charity for Mulvane, with Greiner dropping a quick jump shot through. Valley came alive in the second period, but were down at the half 22-18.

The Wildcats lost no time in the third quarter as Peckham came alive to dump in nine points as Mulvane led at the 3rd quarter mark 37-24.

Sophomore Jerry Kimble and senior Keith Greiner each sunk a pair of fielders in the fourth quarter and the Wildcats never lost the advantage as the game ended at 50-42. Langhove of Valley Center scored 19 points.

Mulvane won the "B" game 59-57 with Dale Greiner scoring 14 points and Jerry Kimble sank 13 points to lead the "Bees".
