Winfield Wins

Cold shooting in the second half proved to be Mulvane's downfall as the Wildcats dropped a 45-40 non-league game to the Winfield Vikings last Friday.

In all, Mulvane hit 16 field goals on 50 attempts for a chilly 32 percent. Things weren't much better at the foul line. There, Mulvane collected on eight of 24 attempts for just 33 percent.
