

Vikings Conquer Cats

The Mulvane Wildcats suffered an opening game loss to Winfield Friday night, 67-59. The Cats under first year coach Roger Pock held a slim 4 point lead at half-time 31 to 27 but could not hold onto the lead and the Winfield Vikings came out the second half all fired up. The Vikings ripped the cords 10 times for 22 points in the third quarter while holding the Wildcats to 16 points. Coach Pock stated that he thought the difference in the game was the Vikings out rebounded the Wildcats 41 to 22. The Wildcats were led by Seniors Robbie Fry (20), and Mark (Chucki) Steadman (16). Winfield was paced by Senior Brad Wimmer who scored 20 points.

The board work for the Wildcats was led by Senior Scott Elston who pulled down

6 caroms. The Wildcats jumped out to a 15 to 14 lead in the first quarter as Brad Butts scored 8 of his 13 points. In the second quarter Fry scored 10 points of the Wildcats 16 and the Wildcats took a 31 to 27 lead into the locker rooms.

Brad Wimmer of the Vikings came out in the third quarter and scored 10 of the Vikings 22 points and the Vikings took a two-point lead into the final quarter. In the fourth quarter Mulvane's Mark Steadman scored 6 but his points were checked by Wimmer who scored 6 for Winfield. The Vikings went on to score 18 points to the Wildcats 12. The next game for the Cats is at Cheney on Tuesday night and Goddard on Friday night.
