

Wildcats Lose To Augusta, 44-41

The Mulvane high school Wildcats lost a close 44 to 41 Chisholm league game to the Augusta Orioles here last Friday night, before a capacity home crowd.

The Orioles, one of the top rated teams in the league, found the Wildcats almost more than they could handle last Friday night. Augusta built up a 14 to 7 lead in the opening period, but the Wildcats roared back in the second stanza to score 17 points, and lead at halftime, 24-21. At the end of the third quarter the score was knotted at 34 all.
