

Wildcat Explosion Tops Andover Trojans, 53-36

Mulvane High School Wildcats erupted for 19 points in the second period and went on to speed by the Andover Trojans, 53-36, in a game played here on Friday.

Going into the second stanza, Mulvane held a slim, 12-10, lead. Senior center Dan Carmichael, 6-7, led the explosion with nine tallies and 5-11 guard Skip Day came off the bench to pour in eight points.

During the period, the Wildcats netted 8 of 15 shots from the field. The 'Cats held Andover to just nine points. During the drive, forward Brian Bobrovicz grabbed four defensive rebounds. The 'Cats made just four turnovers in the period.

In the second half, Mulvane battled off a couple of Trojan threats. At one point in the third period, Andover moved to within eight points.

Late in the ball game, with the contest out of reach, Coach Carl Felver got a "deliberate" technical foul. Felver inserted sophomore Jessie Morgan into the line-up and Morgan's name

was not on the varsity score-book. Morgan will soon be moving to Arizona and it was his final game as a member of the squad, so Felver made sure that he got some varsity action.

Overall, Mulvane hit 49 percent of their shots from the field, canning 26 of 53. Dan Carmichael paced the Mulvane rebounders with nine. Bobrovicz and Brent Fleming had eight each.

Carmichael also topped the Mulvane scoring with 22 points, while Skip Day added 12 tallies.
