Mulvane Cats will be after the Christmas holiday when the team travels to Circle.

"We did zero," pointed out Pock. "We never got into the offense. We had kids coming and going. It was just a total team breakdown. I don't know why."

What really perplexed Pock was that in Friday night's victory over Augusta, the Wildcats played super basketball, super effort.

"Mental preparedness, it all boils down to mental preparedness," added Pock. "I told the kids afterwards that they just weren't ready. You've got to be mentally ready the day of a game."

"Haven's a super ball club, though. I don't want to take anything away from Coach Trimmell. We tried everything but nothing seemed to work."

Haven gunned in 50 percent of its field shots, 30 of 60, to key the victory but that didn't surprise Trimmell. "We've got a good shooting ball club," said Trimmell. "And the kids work hard to get the good shot."

Six-foot-three senior Mike Ledgerwood was the No. 1 culprit as he scored 22 points for the visiting Wildcats, 14 coming in the second quarter as Haven outscored Mulvane, 21-14, to take command, 37-24.

Senior Courtney Gammon headed Mulvane's scoring effort with 14 points and junior Mark Smith scored 10, the only two in double figures.

Haven also beat Mulvane in rebounding, 32-22. Smith had seven rebounds for Pock's club.

The Mulvane B-team was impressive against Haven, manhandling the visitors, 67-51.

Junior Jeff Staska scored 25 points, 13 coming in a big second quarter when Mulvane took charge of the game. Ed Nelson added 13 points for Mulvane.

The Wildcat boys were in form for their first triumph of the season against Augusta. Playing with extreme intensity, the Cats pulled away in the second half.

Courtney Gammon led the Wildcats with 19 points and guard Troy Wayman finally found his scoring eye with 16 points.

Mulvane also commanded the backboards, taking a 35-25 edge there, behind junior Gary Fortner and Gammon, each with seven rebounds, and junior Mark Smith with 10.
