

Take 69-66 Win Over Augusta

The Mulvane high school Wildcats grabbed a 69 to 66 victory over the Augusta Orioles Tuesday night at Augusta, to give them their fourth straight victory without a loss. Gordon Long sank two free throws for the Wildcats, with just about 20 seconds remaining, to lengthen the Mulvane lead of one point.

Mulvane jumped out to a 20 to 8 lead in the opening period and at halftime held a 38 to 28 advantage. Mulvane increased their lead a bit in the 3rd quarter, and it was in the final period that Augusta put on a drive that netted them 26 points and pulled them within one point, before Long's charity tosses iced the Wildcats' victory.

All five of the Wildcats starters scored in double figures — Long led with 21 points, Steve Carmichael had 13, Mickey Davey had 12, Ted Richardson had 11, and Steve Roney had 10. Bruce Kimble, the only substitute seeing action, scored 2 points.

The Mulvane B team lost to the Orioles reserves by a score of 60 to 51. Mulvane led through the first three periods, but fell before a 24 point scoring splurge by the Augusta reserves in the final period.
