

Wildcats Win Over Goddard

The Mulvane high school Wildcats concluded their activity before the Christmas vacation by playing two games away from home — they won over Goddard Tuesday night by a score of 83 to 64, while last Friday night they lost to Valley Center, 62 to 45.

In the game against Goddard the Wildcats built up a 43 to 33 halftime lead, and then in the third period they really moved away, hitting for 23 points, while holding Goddard to 7 counters.

The Wildcats out-rebounded the Goddard Lions and at the same time had a terrific high percentage at hitting their field goals, to post their highest scoring game of the season. Richardson led the Wildcat scoring with 24 points, followed by Johns with 19, and Carmichael had 15.

In the Valley Center game the Wildcats trailed at halftime 43 to 26, and then the Hornets really put the contest away in the third period as they scored 16 points, while holding the Wildcats to 5. Scoring in the final period was even, with each team getting 14 points.
